Permit Stickers are **REQUIRED** to use the Solid Waste Transfer Station Facility.

The fee for the one year permit will be \$2.00.

The permit sticker will be valid September 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>.

Patrons who use the recycling center only **WILL NOT** be required to purchase the permit sticker.

## PLEASE NOTE

**YOU ARE REQUIRED TO STOP AT THE ATTENDANTS SHED PRIOR TO UNLOADING YOUR VEHICLE TO HAVE YOUR LOAD EXAMINED**

### Recyclables

The recycling center continues to be open and free to all residents of the county.

*Note: All recyclables should be rinsed and free of contaminates*

Plastics: #1 and #2 are accepted. Also accepted are some rigid plastics (see attendant).  
**Flatten all plastic containers and remove all lids.**

Tin/Aluminum Cans: Remove all labels

Cardboard: Flatten containers (no yellow foreign cardboard accepted)

Paper: Newspaper, magazines, telephone books, paperbacks with covers removed.  
**Do NOT** recycle envelopes, junk mail, or paper containing adhesives or stickers.

Office paper and shredded paper is acceptable, but should be separated from the above mentioned materials.

### Demolition Debris

Demolition Debris: Demolition debris will cost 12¢ per pound for a disposal fee. Demolition debris is any construction or repair material that is not otherwise classified as municipal solid waste, recyclable goods, or clean wood waste, and may consist of the following materials but is not limited to the following:

Ceramic Sink/Toilets/Tubs  
All Wood  
Paneling

Plastic Pipe  
Rugs/Carpets  
Sheetrock

Sideboards  
Tile/Flooring  
Windows/Doors

Roofing Shingles ½ ton pickup \$60.00

Roofing Shingles 1 ton rack truck \$120.00

Truckloads over 1 ton must be weighed, the fee is 12¢ per pound.

Stoves/Washers/Dryers	\$5.00
Water Heaters	\$5.00
Microwaves, VCR, DVD, Satellite Receivers, etc.	\$5.00
Auto and Light Truck Batteries	\$3.00
Oil Tanks up to 300 gallons (all tanks must be clean)	\$5.00
Oil Tanks 301 up to 1000 gallons (all tanks must be clean)	\$8.00
Oil Tanks over 1000 gallons (all tanks must be clean)	\$10.00
Propane Tanks with valves (up to and including 20 pounds)	\$3.00

**(Note: Tanks cannot be accepted without valves.)**

## Tires

Up to 16 inches without rims	\$3.00
Up to 16 inches with rims	\$5.00
16 inch tires without rims	\$4.00
16 inch tires with rims	\$6.00

All other tires will be weighed and disposal cost shall be 15¢ per pound.

## Universal Waste

Television/Computer Monitors 19-24 inches	\$5.00
Televisions 25-36 inches	\$12.00
Televisions 37-60 inches	\$20.00
Fluorescent Light Bulbs	25¢ per foot

## Ash

Ash from wood, coal, and pellet stoves will cost 10¢ per pound for a disposal fee.

## Solid Waste Bag Fees – As of November 1, 2013

Small Bags (20 Gallon)	\$1.50 each
Large Bags (30 Gallon)	\$2.00 each

Bags are sold at your local Town Office and other locations designated by the individual towns.

**All bags are required to be securely tied. Any overflow removed from the bag to allow proper closure will be charged a 8¢ per pound fee or an additional bag may be purchased.**

All solid waste delivered by commercial haulers or in improper bags will be weighed and a 8¢ per pound disposal fee will be charged. (as of November 1, 2013)

**Attendants have the right to adjust prices according to the circumstances at hand.**
