ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into a lease purchase agreement for a Loader Backhoe for the Machias Public Works Department, said lease/purchase is estimated to cost up to \$110,000.00 and is not to exceed a five year term.

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town of Machias vote to approve a Community Development Block Grant application for the Public Infrastructure Grant program in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 and to submit same to the Department of Economic and Community Development and if said program is approved, to authorize the municipal officers to accept said grant funds, to make such assurances, assume such responsibilities, and exercise such programs. Furthermore, the Town of Machias is cognizant of the requirement that should the intended National Objective of the CDBG program not be met all CDBG funds must be repaid to the State of Maine CDBG program.
